2. Presenter's surname and name

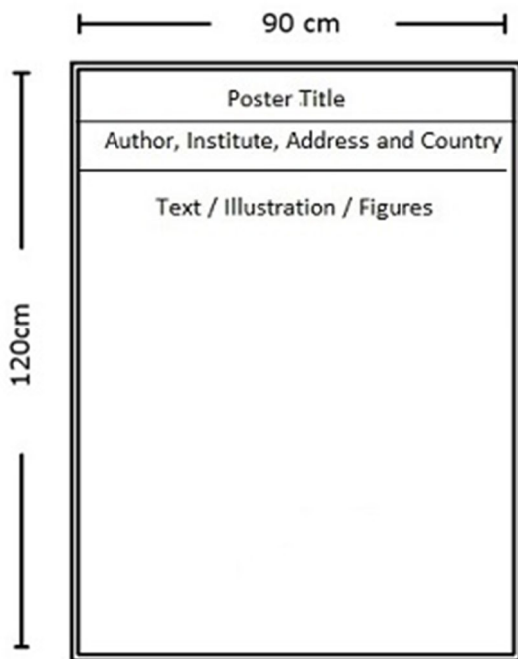
3. Affiliation, office address, phone, fax, e-mail

POSTER PREPARATION

Please note the following information for the preparation of your poster. Please bring your printed poster with you to the International Course.

- The posters must be in English.
- The poster layout is portrait.
- The dimensions of the poster should not exceed 90 cm wide x 1.2m long.
- Please prepare your poster on one sheet paper.
- Allocate the top of the poster for title, authors and abstract.
- Text, illustrations, etc. should be large enough to be read from a distance of 1 meter.
- Pins will be available for mounting the posters.
- The suggested template for the poster is as below:
